

THE Six Days of Creation

Seven days defined by periods of light and dark. "yom" = ONE literal day.

The Jewish day begins at SUNDOWN:

Genesis 1:5 God called the light day, and the darkness He called night. And there was

evening and there was morning, one day.

DAYS:

- 1) Gen 1:3-5 light/dark
- 2) Gen 1:6-8 - divide the waters, above/below
- 3) Gen 1:9-13 - dry land, seas, grass, fruit
- 4) Gen 1:14-19 - sun, stars (signs & seasons)
- 5) Gen 1:20-23 - water creatures, birds
- 6) Gen 1:24-28 - cattle, creeping things, man
- Gen 1:26 - Let us make man in our image... have dominion... be fruitful and multiply.*
- 7) REST - Exodus 20:9; Deut 5:13

Fall of man - promise of the seed Gen 3:15
Price for sin - DEATH - Gen 3:21 - tunics of skin... blood was shed for their sin...
